



COURSE OVERVIEW

This Professional Certificate is developed for aesthetic professionals to obtain a licence from the Radiological Council of WA to perform tattoo removal using Q-Switched, class 4 laser modalities. It provides a holistic approach to laser practice within a cosmetic medical setting. This course is divided into an online theory component and optional supervised hours (hands-on laser training).

- Laser and light physics
- Laser safety
- Tattoos and ink
- Q-switched laser parameters
- Wound healing post laser tattoo removal
- Hands-on laser training in a 2:1 Student to Trainer ratio
